

# VSA's Australian Travel Guide

## Current Border Status & Quarantine Info

All international travellers have a mandatory 14 day quarantine period imposed by the Federal Government.

Individual state restrictions are outlined below.

	Border Status	Quarantine
Northern Territory	Closed	14 days for all non-essential travellers at a designated location
ACT	Open	14 days for international arrivals
Queensland	Closed	14 days for international arrivals
South Australia	Closed	14 days for all travellers at a designated location
Tasmania	Closed	14 days for all travellers at a designated location
Victoria	Open	14 days for international arrivals
Western Australia	Closed	14 days for all travellers at a designated location
New South Wales	Open	14 days for international arrivals

Travellers instructed to quarantine at a designated location will be required to cover their own costs.

Essential personnel including health and emergency services are among a list of exemptions to travel and quarantine conditions.

Exemptions will vary between states.
